  "jetty", as shown in the photographs of 2000 and 2004.

Clerk and Cllr Deacon have suggested this to Babergh DC. Clerk will follow up. *Cllr Hawkins* said that 78 houses were being proposed at Holbrook opposite the school. This would add to the traffic on the B1456. Clerk to check with Cllr Deacon.
